



SMOKING FREE

Rationale:

The Board of Trustees is committed to ensuring that the requirements and objectives of the Smoke-free Environments Act 1990 are met to prevent, so far as is reasonably practicable, the detrimental effects of smoking on the health of non-smokers within the school and its environment.

Guidelines:

1. The Board of Trustees is committed to maintaining a smoke-free environment within the school and its grounds.
2. The Board of Trustees has a commitment to ensure that staff and students are protected from tobacco smoke, thus maintaining the highest environmental standards in respect of tobacco smoke.
3. The Board of Trustees will take all reasonable practicable steps to ensure that no person smokes within the school or its grounds at any time on any day.
4. The Board of Trustees will ensure that prominent notices prohibiting smoking are displayed in appropriate places throughout the school and the school grounds.
5. The Board of Trustees will ensure that students are educated about the detrimental effects of smoking and tobacco smoke on health.

Review
